Income and expenses are comparable to last year. No major expenses or lack of income. We're in good shape.

Deacon's report: Lisa West

- We thank North Hadley for their hospitality during July; they worshipped with us in August. We thank the Parkers for hosting at their home though we had to shift inside due to weather.
- Deacons have planned the church calendar through the end of December with Communion Sunday, All Saints' Day, Stewardship Sunday, Pageant, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, and the Sunday after Christmas.

Christian Ed: Lila West

- We thank Shannon for doing such a great job. Very successful spring with Children's Sunday and Baccalaureate Sunday.
- We're looking at new curricula and trying to provide more opportunities for teens.
- They are moving forward with a candidate for the nursery position.

Properties: Kurt Betchik

- Steeple repair: Waiting for the engineer to provide plans. Contractor's rough estimate for the repair is \$218,500. Would remove the spire and bell section and possibly the clock and do repairs on the ground. They hope to get started this Fall.
- Building was inspected in June and there are things that need to be done by a licensed electrician. It will be an expensive project but it can be spread over years.
- Kurt and Steve Robertson have been painting handrails and windows. This has been a multi-year project. We appreciate their efforts which are saving the church thousands of dollars.
